IOWA HIGH SCHOOL GOLF COACHES ASSOCIATION HALL OF FAME NOMINATION CRITERIA

- 1. **Must** be retired from coaching golf
- 2. **Must** have coached golf at least 15 years
- 3. **Must** have provided some service to high school golf, either at the State or local level

A candidate **must** meet the first 3 criteria. Then the Leadership Board will look at following criteria to decide if the candidate is to be elected into the Hall of Fame:

- 1. Number of times team/individual qualified to State
- 2. Number of State titles won
- 3. Number of Conferences titles won.

TIMELINE:

- 1. Turn in Nomination form end of April
- 2. Hall of Fame Committee prioritizes nominations end of May
- 3. Leadership Council votes on nominations end of June
- 4. Hall of Fame inductees are announced end of August
- 5. Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony middle of March @ Iowa St. Clinic
